## Peer Counseling

We share ideas, information and personal issues. Everything is confidential.

## Skills Training

We help people with things like employment skills, money management and looking for a place to live.



## Advocacy

We teach people to understand their rights, like the right to an interpreter. We teach people how to speak for themselves

We help people fill out applications and understand letters.

## Communication Assistance

We have a video phone and TTY. We train people how to use them.
